Bylaw 13 (j)	A candidate for the office of President, Vice-President or General Secretary must be nominated by at least four member organisations from different countries, including his/her own organisation. Nomination for these offices, together with a statement signed by the candidate accepting nomination must be filed with the General Secretary not less than four months prior to the opening of the Congress. Bylaw 9 (a)	(Resolutions) They shall be translated and distributed to the member organisations at least three months prior to the opening of the Congress.	22 April 2011
